Las Lomas Student Receives
Michael W. De Sa Memorial Scholarship

(Walnut Creek, Calif., June 10, 2016) - - The 10th annual *Michael W. De Sa Memorial Scholarship*, administered by the Walnut Creek Education Foundation, was awarded to Las Lomas High school senior Jack Kane. The \$2,000 scholarship was presented to Mr. Kane during the Las Lomas High School Senior Awards Night held on Tuesday, May 31st.

The De Sa Family selected Kane from a large pool of Las Lomas seniors who applied for the scholarship. His achievements exemplify the scholarship criteria, which seek a well-rounded graduate of the Walnut Creek schools (attending K-12) who has “nurtured life’s passions both in school and outside the confines of academia, through service in the community and other pursuits.”

An award-winning athlete throughout his freshman and sophomore years at Las Lomas, Kane suffered a severe injury during his junior year and was forced to redirect the leadership skills he developed through football and track. He more than rose to the occasion, using his free time to mentor new players both on and off the field, demonstrably improving their performance. “I have developed an appreciation,” says Kane, “of those who put forward the most effort regardless of natural ability and are guided by a purpose beyond self-satisfaction.” At the end of his final football season, Kane was recognized as a First Team All-League Running Back and honored with the player-nominated Team Award.

After graduation from Las Lomas High School, Kane will major in Construction Management at Colorado State University.
